Dan Transue graduated from Point Pleasant High School in 1987. During his years in high school, he excelled in football, wrestling and track. He attained second team All-Shore honors in both football and track and first team All-Shore in wrestling. His javelin record throw of 193'3" is still a Panther record. He was the Senior Male Athlete of the Year, and placed second in the balloting for All-Around Male Athlete in Ocean County and the Shore Conference.

Dan attended Rutgers University from 1987 to 1990 where his overall record in wrestling was 34 wins and 7 losses. In 1988



he was voted the most improved wrestler. In 1993 he moved on to Springfield College where he made the All America team as a junior, and as a senior was ranked #1 in the country for Division II heavyweights. He finished his outstanding wrestling career at Springfield with an overall record of 60 wins and 10 losses.

Since graduating from high school, Dan has served as a volunteer coach on many levels, including Little League Baseball, Pop Warner Football, High School track and wrestling, and Middle School wrestling.

Having graduated from Springfield College in 1995 with a degree in Rehabilitation Services, he currently is Program Manager/Treatment Coordinator at the Tri-County Youth Programs, DMH Facility in Springfield, Mass. This facility is a 24 hour staff-secure adolescent treatment facility. Dan is responsible for creating and implementing treatment plans, behavior modification programs, and training staff for the care of seven male adolescents with sexual offending and fire setting behaviors.

Dan resides in Springfield, Mass. with his wife Christine and their son Matthew.
